Websites and Elections

The Foundation Team is embarking on development of a website specifically for the Deschutes Rim Clinic Foundation. Its original 'home' was within the Deschutes Rim Clinic website, but the breadth of information to publicize made it imperative the information be housed on its own site. This will facilitate access to that information as well. Website completion is anticipated by mid-March.

Meanwhile, clinic staff are developing a new, user and access-friendly Deschutes Rim Health Clinic website which will be mostly devoted to the clinic, its services, providers, and patient information. Information on the White River Health District, to include Board meetings and materials, financials and policies and procedures will also be on this site. A launch of this new website is anticipated by late March.

Meanwhile, those who have tried to access the [current clinic website](#) will find it is currently down due to a re-licensing process. This site should be back up by early March. We apologize for the inconvenience this inaccessibility may have caused.

Every two years, Wasco County holds a Special District Election to elect board members for the various county districts such as schools, fire, water, library, as well as health districts. This year the election is May 18th.

The White River Health District will have 5 board vacancies. Three vacancies will be due to the expired 4-year terms of three existing members. There are also two positions with unexpired 2-year terms that need to be officially filled through this election. If you are interested in filing for a board position, a special form on the County's website (under Elections) will need to be completed and filed by March 18th.

The Board of Directors of the Deschutes Rim Health Clinic also serves as the board for the Deschutes Rim Clinic Foundation. This is an excellent opportunity to be involved in the growth of health care in South Wasco County that includes a new medical facility, new partnerships, and renewed commitment to providing high quality, comprehensive, and compassionate health care to our neighbors in the region.
